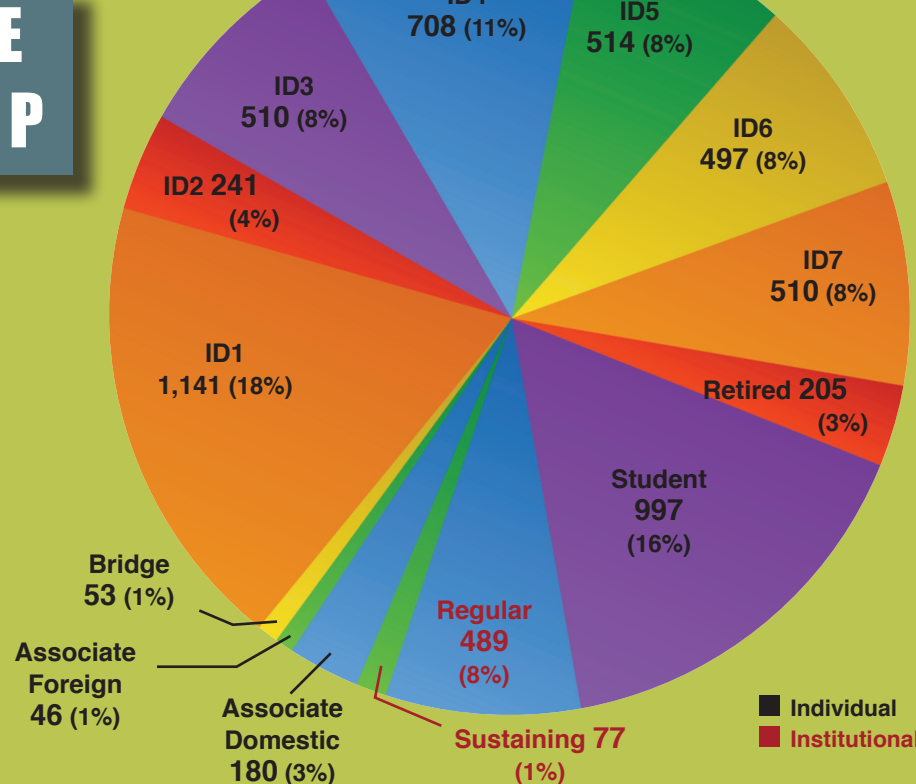

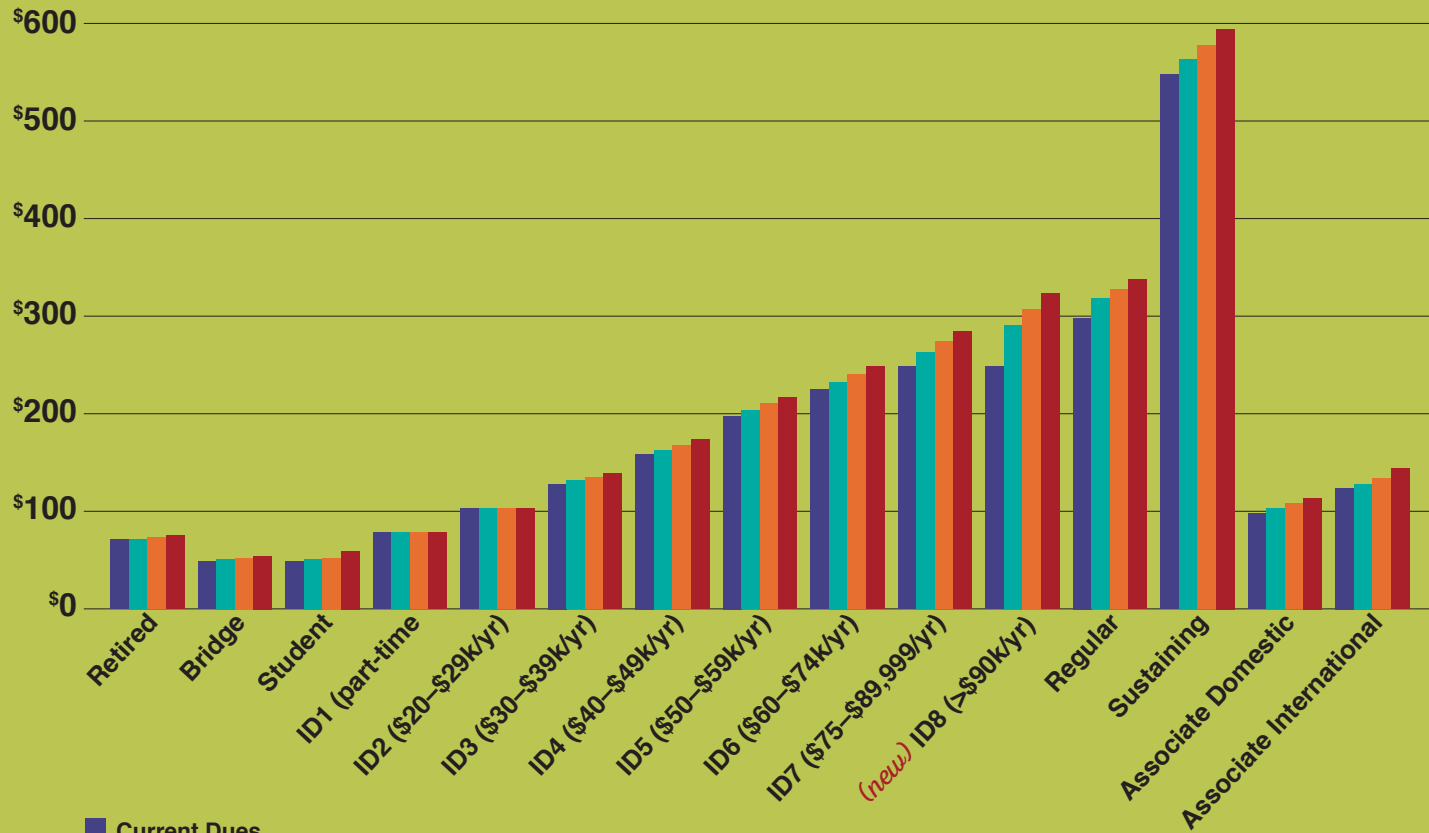

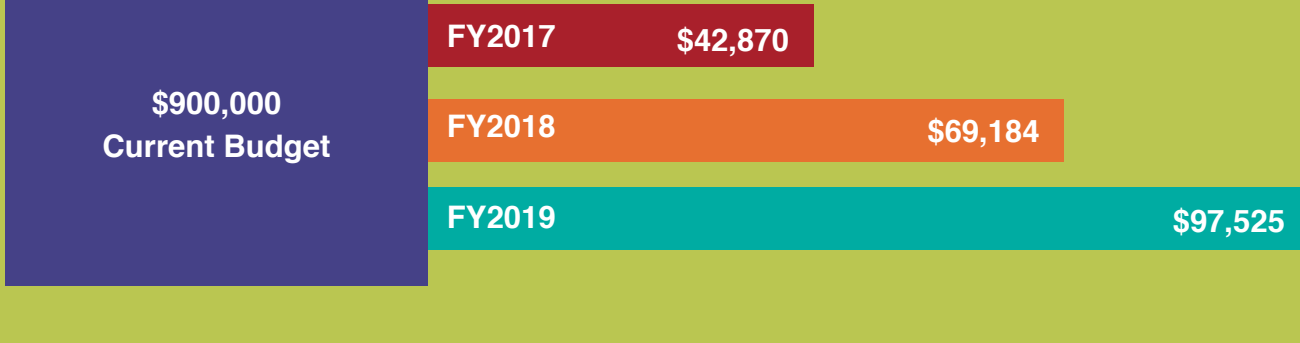
### PROPOSED DUES INCREASE

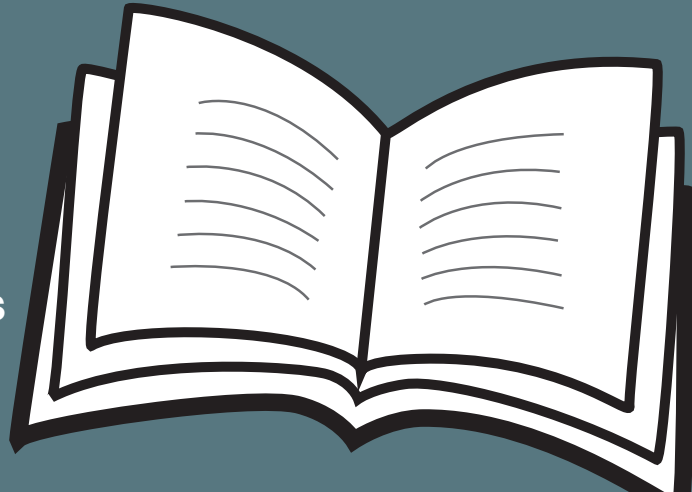
